1540 28<sup>th</sup> S.E. Meijer. Meijer opened a 17,000-square-foot grocery store here in 1958. In 1962, a 75,000-square-foot expansion housing non-grocery items made this Meijer Thrifty Acres, the chain's first supercenter. The store eventually grew to 185,000 square feet, serving 30,000 customers a week. In April, 2009, over the objections of some neighbors, the City Planning Commission gave Meijer the go-ahead to tear down the 50-year-old store and replace it on site with a compact supercenter of 156,000 square feet.
