1050 Iroquois S.E. Ottawa Hills High School / Iroquois Middle School. In 1923, the Grand Rapids Board of Education purchased the site to construct a



K-12 school. Built as Ottawa Hills High School in 1925, the 200,000-square-foot building was so occupied until the new Ottawa Hills High was built at Burton and Rosewood in 1972. The elementary wing was added in the 1930's. The school was renovated in 1978 to house Iroquois Middle School, which

closed in 2007. For the next year, the school was the temporary home of Burton Elementary and Middle School while that building was being renovated. In 2008, the Grand Rapids Christian Schools purchased the building and campus for \$1.95 million, but the building was far too large for its slated purposes. It was demolished in the summer of 2009.
