235 Straight N.W. The Steil Youth Center was dedicated December 1, 2000. It is operated by Grand Rapids Youth Commonwealth and named for state Sen. Glenn Steil, who contributed \$250,000 toward the project. A large Paul Collins painting at the center's entrance features Police Officer Connie M. Moore with her arm around a boy, standing behind Sen. Steil. The facility replaced an older building at 252 Indiana N.W., which was torn down in 1990 after it was determined to be structurally unsound.
